

SKI-24, March 27 and 28, 2021

the ultimate challenge for team cross-country skiing!

The ski-24 is a cross-country relay race by teams, which takes place every year towards the end of March at the Espace Nordic in Col des Mosses. The origin of the ski-24 adventure dates from 2011, when in Scandinavia eight friends challenge each other to ski non-stop for 24 hours, taking it in turns. Once back to Switzerland, an organization committee was founded and the first edition of the ski-24 was born in 2013.

After seven editions, ski-24 is proud of being part of the Nordic calendar, with an increasing number of participants (more than 2013) and a festive end-of-the-season atmosphere, perfect for skiers and everyone else. Indeed, this race gathers elites and amateurs skiers on two 4 km loop. 1 to 10-people teams relay as they wish in order to make as many km as possible from Saturday noon, till Sunday noon. The present record is held by the Team Gel Interim-Rossignol: 572 km. A record prize has been created, and if the winning team cannot beat the record, its km total is added in Swiss Francs (CHF) to the prize of the following year. The record prize for the next edition will be CHF 1968,-

A kids race is organized as well on Saturday afternoon, a one km loop for teams of 3 to 5 participants.



What You Can Look Forward To:

Beyond the undeniable physical challenge, the ski-24 is characterized by strong values such as camaraderie, team spirit, mutual assistance, reunion and friendship. This event offers several activities besides the competition itself, such as DJ night, games and competitions for kids, exhibition stands, snow-bar on the path, and also a giant Jacuzzi next to the loop.

Over the past six years, the ski-24 has become the third biggest cross-country skiing race in Switzerland as per participants, and the biggest 24h cross-country skiing race in the world. The innovative concept and the investments turned this competition into a major event for cross-country skiers of all levels, kids, parents, spectators, partners, local authorities and loyal sponsors.

You surely understood it already, the ski-24 is the ideal competition for teams of friends who wish to live an unforgettable experience!



Rules for participation:

The Ski-24 is open to anybody, born in 2006 or before, with a race license or not.

The mini ski-24 is open to all child born in 2005 or before

Important: A child born in 2005 or 2006, can also participate at the mini ski-24 (1h30), but can only compete in one of these 2 races (ski-24 or mini ski-24).

Solo:	1 runner	(born in 2000 or older)
Challenge:	2 - 3 runners	(born in 2000 or older)
Women's team:	4 -10 runners / the whole team must be made up of women only	(born in 2006 or older)
Men's team:	4 -10 runners	(born in 2006 or older)
Mixed team:	4 -10 runners	(born in 2006 or older)
Mini Girls	3, 4 or 5 girls	(born in 2005 or older)
Mini Boys	3, 4 or 5 boys	(born in 2005 or older)
