

Tartu Marathon in Estonia

February 26th – March 1st, 2027

With your gracious guiding services from the Sandoz Concept

Estonia's Tartu Marathon is the most important Nordic ski competition throughout all of the Baltic countries, and not just because of the number of participants. Usually there are 6,000 skiers attacking a racecourse that is 63 kilometers long. The departure is at Otepää, which is the best-known winter resort in all of Estonia. The race finishes at Elva. This classic only race is a "must" for the region. The course varies between spectacular countryside, sometimes in the forest and sometimes along frozen lakes. The amount of climbing is modest, but challenging nonetheless, so you shouldn't underestimate it! The organizers of this race have years of experience; therefore, it is run well. The tracks will be perfectly prepared. A festive atmosphere both at Tartu and at d'Otepää guarantees a fantastic trip. It was organized for the first time in 1960.

Our accommodations for the race are in Otepää. Its location is ideal, allowing you to easily go to the start and to return to your hotel after the finish in Elva. You will get your race bibs in the stadium "Tehvandi". The small town Tartu is only 30 minutes from Otepää, this is just another reason for you to visit and explore this superb town that hides numerous little-known treasures.



Here Is Your Program for This Great Race:

Friday, 26.02.2027

You will arrive by plane at Tallinn and then be transferred by bus to your hotel in Otepää. It is about a 2,5 hours ride. You will unpack your bags and will be free to do what is right for you, such a short training like a run or visit Otepää and of course waxing your skis for the next day. We will all have dinner together and afterwards you will receive information about the rest of the trip.

Saturday, 27.02.2027

You will have a copious breakfast and then you will take a look at the stadium for the race on Sunday, try out your equipment, check on your kick wax and then there will be a short training on the race course, after that you will pick up your race bibs situated direct in the stadium "Tehvandi". We will all have lunch in Otepää in your hotel. Then it is time to work on your skis again—you've got to have them perfect for the next day! We will all have dinner together and afterwards you will be fully informed about the race on Sunday.

Sunday, 28.02.2027

It is time to get up early! Another big breakfast and then you will go by skis from your hotel to the departure stadium "Tehvandi" in Otepää. The race starts at 9:00 in 16 different waves. You can leave your personal effects in the trucks that the race organizers have provided for you and they will be available at the finish.

There will be refueling stops along the course every 10 kilometers. Remember that you will be going through forests alongside and over frozen lakes until you reach Elva. Once you have passed the finish line, you can find your personal bags of clothes, food, etc. before you take the bus that the race organizers will provide for you. It will take you to Otepää. We will all eat dinner to celebrate in the hotel.

Monday, 01.03.2027

Breakfast at the hotel and then transfer by bus to Tallinn airport where you will take your return flight.

The Tartu Marathon can be combined with Vasaloppet Week, which takes place immediately after the marathon in Estonia, starting on Monday 1 March. Instead of flying back, you can continue from Helsinki to Stockholm. During the week, you can take part in the 45-kilometre *Half Vasaloppet* or the night race on Friday evening. The main 90-kilometre race takes place on Sunday 7 March.
