

## Vasaloppet 2027

### **The Biggest Nordic Ski Race in the World!**

**7<sup>th</sup> March 2027 – Guided Tour for either 4 or 7 Days**

The 90 km Vasaloppet in classic style is the most popular and oldest race in the history of cross-country skiing. It is "the" race of the World Long Distance Championship, the Worldloppet. The race starts on the first Sunday in March (7 March 2027) at 8 a.m. in Sälen, as it has since 1922! Every year, around 16,500 participants compete in classic style over the distance between Sälen and Mora, through forests, hills and frozen lakes. Taking part in this exceptional race will leave you with unforgettable memories. Thanks to the many spectators along the route, you will soon forget the difficult moments and the finish in the centre of Mora will be a spectacular and magical experience!

There are several other races to choose from during the week, such as a 30 or 45 km race as well as a relay of 5 runners on the original 90 km course, all in classic style, or the famous "Vasanight" or Vasa by night over 30, 45 or 90 km in freestyle, with a start at 8 p.m. on Friday evening, either as an individual or in teams of two!

The various events are accompanied by the Sandoz Concept Team: there is no doubt that the experience of Daniel Sandoz, with several editions of the Vasa to his credit, including a top 10, as well as the precious advice of his team will be an asset for our participants.

**Course description:**

The Vasaloppet is the longest and oldest race in the history of cross-country skiing. Start at 8 am from Sälen. There are seven checkpoints on the course. For example, the checkpoint at Evertsberg, 48 km away, which you have to reach by 2.30 pm at the latest. The finish is in Mora in the centre of the town.

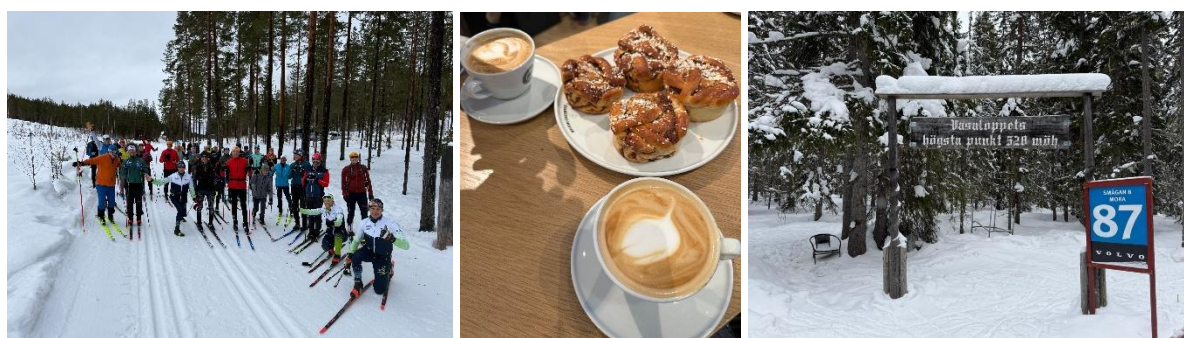

**Package1: 7 days 01.03.-08.03.2027 (Monday to Monday) with accommodation in the Kungshaga Hotel in Orsa**

**Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2027**

International flight from the airport of your choice. For participants coming from Switzerland, France, Germany or Italy, a bus transfer from Stockholm-Arlanda airport is organised in the middle of the afternoon to your hotel in Orsa. For those arriving on their own and after the bus has left (and in order not to keep other participants waiting unnecessarily), the transfer should be arranged by train to Mora station (trains leave from under Arlanda airport, train fare is extra).

**Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March to Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Each day in the week leading up to the race is dedicated to reconnaissance of a part of the course, from the start in Sälen to the finish in the centre of Mora. There will also be various activities for accompanying persons during the week.

**Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Participation in the Vasaloppet in classic style over a distance of 90 km. Wake up at dawn and have a hearty breakfast. Transfer with our own bus from your hotel to the start of the race, which is at 8 am. On arrival in Mora and for participants staying in Orsa, our shuttles will be waiting for you and will take you to your hotel according to your arrival time and the time you deem necessary to eat and enjoy the atmosphere in the city. For those staying in hotels in Mora, the return journey is on foot. Last evening with dinner together in your hotel and last night.

**Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Transfer by bus to Stockholm and flight back to your departure airport.

**Package 2: 4 days from 04.03. to 08.03.2027 (Thursday to Monday) with accommodation in Mora or Orsa**

**Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

International flight from the airport of your choice. For participants coming from Switzerland, France, Germany or Italy, a bus transfer from Stockholm-Arlanda airport is organised in the middle of the afternoon to your hotels in Orsa or Mora. For those arriving on their own and after the bus has left (and in order not to keep other participants waiting unnecessarily), the transfer should be arranged by train to Mora station (trains leave from under Arlanda airport, train travel is extra).

**Friday 5<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Friday morning reconnaissance of the last 17 km to the arrival in the centre of Mora. Free afternoon with the collection of your race number in the large multi-purpose tent right next to the finish line. Saturday morning visit (optional) to the Nordic centre or the Grönklitt animal park and preparation of the equipment for the next day's race. Dinner in the evening.

**Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Participation in the Vasaloppet in classic style over the distance of 90 km. Wake up at dawn and have a hearty breakfast. Transfer with our own bus from your hotel to the start of the race, which is at 8 am. On arrival in Mora and for participants staying in Orsa, our shuttles will be waiting for you and will take you to your hotel according to your arrival time and the time you deem necessary to eat and enjoy the atmosphere in the city. For those staying in the hotel in Mora, the return journey is on foot (250 metres from the finish line). Last evening with dinner together in your hotel and last night.

**Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2027**

Transfer by bus to Stockholm and flight back to your departure airport.

## Your Accommodations

### The Kungshaga Hotel, Orsa

This family-run hotel with a friendly atmosphere offers 29 rooms. Free internet access is available in the lobby and in the lounge. In the basement you will find a sauna and a specially equipped waxing room. The double rooms are equipped with 2 single beds, shower, toilet and television. A good sports meal is guaranteed in this beautiful house with its rooms offering a relaxing view of Orsasjön lake! The hotel is located in Orsa, 10 km from Mora, where the Vasaloppet finish is held. Transfers to and from the official Vasa course during the week, as well as our private transfer to the start of Sunday's race in Sälen and back after the race, are organised and included in the package.



### The Bishop Arms Hotel\*\*\*, Mora

The hotel is located in the centre of Mora, just 250 metres from the finish line of the Vasaloppet and a short walk from the town's pedestrian street, and is the ideal accommodation for those who wish to stay in Mora itself. All rooms are simple but comfortable and equipped with 2 single beds, a full bathroom with shower and toilet. The hotel also has some single and 3-bed rooms. A waxing room in the basement is available for our group. Breakfast and dinner are served in the hotel's restaurant on the ground floor.
